

Johnsonburg Area School District Act 44 School Safety Report-Public

During the 2022-2023 school year, the following activities and trainings occurred:

- JASD Administration and members of the Threat Assessment Team participated in PCCD Threat Assessment Program training, earning Certificates of Completion.
- The Johnsonburg Borough Police, in conjunction with the St. Mary's K9 Unit, conducted two controlled substance searches of the High School.
- The Pennsylvania State Police conducted a lockdown drill at the Johnsonburg Area Elementary School.
- Safe to Say Trainings were presented to all 6-12 grade students
- A reunification plan was created, and a walk-through was conducted with school staff and other stakeholders.
- Staff were trained in Situational Awareness, CPR, and First Aid.
- Office staff continues to be cautious about allowing visitors to enter the buildings.
- Local law enforcement officers were encouraged to conduct random walk-throughs of the building when time permitted, which did occur.
- Monthly emergency drills were held as a review for staff/students.
- Staff members continue to be trained in Safety Care- nonviolent crisis intervention strategies, verbal de-escalation, and physical restraint/holds.
- The Johnsonburg Area School District continues actively responding to all tips from the Safe-to-Say tipline.
- The Johnsonburg Area School District will continue to be proactive in prevention and intervention strategies regarding safety and security.
